

12 hour / 2 day Paediatric Emergency First Aid for Children and Babies

The 7 hour course in Emergency First Aid has been developed for those who are working with children and babies.

This will be of particular interest to Child Minders and Crèche Assistants, Playground personnel and anyone responsible for youth organisations.

The aim of this course is to provide these persons with a sound knowledge and understanding of First Aid procedures when working with children and babies.

Although the majority of First Aid procedures are similar to those used in adult first aid there are substantial differences in the protocols for resuscitation, choking, casualty handling and incident management.

Subject to ongoing assessment all delegates will receive an HSE recognised certificate in Appointed Person Paediatric – Emergency First Aid in the Workplace, valid for a period of 3 years.
