

RLSS UK EMERGENCY RESPONSE CERTIFICATE (Swimming Pools)

This 14 hour programme in Emergency First Aid has been developed for individuals who wish to gain knowledge of Emergency Procedures and attain a recognised qualification. This Emergency Response Certificate is NOT a lifeguard qualification.

By the end of the course candidates will be able to demonstrate the essential knowledge and skills needed to deal with any First Aid emergencies in the work place.

The course will be assessed by external assessors and all successful students will receive a certificate as recognised by RLSS UK and the Health and Safety Executive (HSE). This certificate is valid for a period of 2 years. Students must be a minimum of 16 years of age at the time they start the course.

Our RLSS UK Pool Lifeguard Trainer Assessors, who conduct the course, have qualifications that are acceptable to the Health and Safety Executive (HSE) and whose registration is acceptable to the Royal Lifesaving Society (RLSS).

Aim High Training and Development are able to tailor this course to meet the requirements of your organisation although you will need to meet the following criteria:

- Pool operators **MUST** have undertaken a comprehensive risk assessment for their swimming facilities
- The pool must have a comprehensive swimming safety policy and detailed Pool Safety Operating Procedures (PSOP)
- Pool operators must make safety information available to pool users

All individuals can be provided with a HSE approved First Aid manual, which includes all of the required First Aid information to accompany the course. This manual does not include any of the water based information.
