

Emergency First Aid in the Workplace for the Appointed Person

The course tutor will carry out an ongoing assessment and all successful students will receive a certificate as recognised by the Health and Safety Executive (HSE). This certificate is valid for a period of 3 years. Students who are under the age of 16 can be issued with an attendance certificate.

Our First Aid Instructors who conduct the course, have qualifications that are acceptable to the Health and Safety Executive for teaching the statutory First Aid and whose registration is acceptable to Nuco Training Ltd.
